

# The Greater Boston Plumbing Contractors Association in partnership with Plumbers and Gasfitters Local 12 donate \$40,000 to the City of Boston Resiliency Fund

The Greater Boston Plumbing Contractors Association in conjunction with Plumbers and Gasfitters Local Union 12, announced today that it has donated \$40,000 to the City of Boston Mayor's Resiliency Fund. The Greater Boston Plumbing Contractors Association, otherwise known as the Greater Boston PCA, represents Boston area Plumbing and Gasfitter Contractors which are signatory to the Local Union 12. A force for good in the Plumbing Industry, the Greater Boston PCA also seeks to give back to the communities in which its Contractors operate.

The \$40,000 donation will serve as a boon to the City of Boston Mayor's Resiliency Fund which was established by Mayor Martin Walsh in the wake of the current COVID-19 Crisis. To date the Resiliency Fund has raised \$30.5 Million and awards grants to provide food to Boston's children, families and seniors, technology to Boston Public Schools students for remote learning, and provide support to first responders, front-line workers and healthcare workers so they can effectively do their job and promote public health.
